- 1. Review General Rules
- 2. Market pigs must be tagged on or before the official weigh-in date and have an official 4-H ear tag.
- 3. Market pigs for exhibit should be farrowed in the current calendar year.
- 4. Barrows and Gilts will show together as market hogs. The pigs will be shown by **weight**, not breeds within their class. Weight classes will be determined by the swine committee to give more equal distribution of weight and numbers per class.
- 5. Minimum weight for selling market pigs through the 4-H livestock sale is 230 lbs., maximum weight is 290 lbs. Animals below and above the weights will not be eligible for Champions or the Sale of Champions.
- 6. No powders or oils may be used in swine or showmanship classes.

2999 - All Market Hogs (See Rule 4 above)

Breeding Gilts

3000 - Breeding gilts born in current calendar year (May be divided by the 4-H Swine Committee depending on the number of entries. The same gilt cannot be shown in both breeding and market classes.)

Swine Showmanship

3004 - Senior, 14 years and older by Jan 1, current year.

3005 - Intermediate, 10-13 years by Jan 1, current year.

3006 - Junior, 7-9 years by Jan 1, current year.
