CLOTHING CONSTRUCTION

1. Read General Rules.
2. Garments may have been worn but shall be carefully laundered or cleaned and pressed before being exhibited.
3. The garment will be judged for construction as it affects total appearance. Considered will be construction detail appropriate to fabric and style of garments; quality of construction, appropriate finishing techniques, and value for money spent.
4. There is no limit to the number of articles that may be exhibited.
5. When garments are brought to the fair, **place all garments on hangers** with hooks toward the right shoulder. Attach slacks, shorts, and skirts to the hangers with large safety pins so garment does not slide to the end of hanger. Cover garment with a clear plastic bag.
6. All articles must have been made within the last year.

1. Read General Rules.
2. Any technique or combination of techniques used to decorate clothing is acceptable for this class.
3. There is no limit to the number of entries.

1. Read General Rules.
 2. Handwork includes any one of the following: Counted Cross-stitch embroidery, needlepoint, crewel, tatting, plastic canvas, macramé, latch hook, or cutwork.
