1. Read General Rules.. (Definitions of (Y, A & S)

All Exhibitors will need to identify behind the class number, either Y, A, or S to indicate age appropriate.

2. There is no limit to the number of articles that you may exhibit. Except group projects which are limited to two entries per group. Coloring pages— limit 3 per person.

3. If an exhibit consists of a set, it will be considered as one exhibit.

4. Craft exhibits made from kits will be accepted. The exhibitor must state on the entry card that the article is from a kit.

5. All articles brought to the Barton County Fair must be the work of the exhibitor and done in the current year.

6. Artwork must be framed or mounted ready to hang. Drawings and paintings should be matted and a hanger attached to the back of the picture.

7. All exhibits **MUST BE READY TO HANG**, complete with hangers. (No tape or string.) Art in frames must have sturdy wire in place for hanging.

8. All paintings must be completely dry.

CERAMICS

100, Y, A, or S: - Hand Built

101, Y, A, or S: - Wheel Thrown

102, Y, A, or S: - Pre-Molded

103, Y, A, or S: - Combination of thrown, slab, molded, etc.

104, Y, A, or S: - Finishing-glazing only

CRAFTS

105, Y, A, or S: - Decorative uses for wine bottles

106, Y, A, or S: - Dolls - made from any medium

107, Y, A, or S: - Holiday - project/article made to coincide with a holiday

108, Y, A, or S: - Kits—project/article made from a kit

109, Y, A, or S: - Painted object (saw, toy box, rocks, stones, wood, drift wood, etc.)

110, Y, A, or S: - Paper folding (origami)

CREATION FROM MEDIUMS

can be natural finish, painted, varnished, oiled, etc.

112, Y, A, or S: - Glass; fused or glued, stained or clear

113, Y, A, or S: - Items found in nature, ie; dried grasses, twigs, soil, sand, weed pods

115, Y, A, or S: - Metal or Corrugated metal (tin)

140, Y, A, or S: - Single Scrapbook Page

141, Y, A, or S: - Scrapbooking

142, Y, A, or S: - Collection of: Group of (5 or less)

143, Y, A, or S: - Collection of: Group of 6 or more

PAINTING

145, Y, A, or S: - Oil painting

REPURPOSE/RECYCLE

MISCELLANEOUS

151, Y, A, or S: - Coloring Page (can use crayons, marker or colored pencils) 8x11 size, can be mounted on colored cardstock or in plastic sleeve. Limit 3 per person.

152, Y, A, or S: - Misc.; any other art/craft not covered
